ORDER EXTENDING TIME

By Decision (D.) 93621 dated October 6, 1981, Southern Pacific Transportation Co. (SP) was ordered to correct certain deficiencies relating to track walkways and clearances no later than October 31, 1981.

By letter dated December 4, 1981, SP advised that it believed the deficiencies were corrected by October 31, 1981; however, the Commission staff (staff) after a series of inspections with SP personnel has taken exception to 19 corrections. SP further advises it is willing to conform its corrections to those suggested by the staff. It, therefore, requests an extension to December 31, 1981, to comply with the staff's suggestions.

The Transportation Division has no objection to the request.

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 1 of D.93621 is amended as follows:

1. Southern Pacific Transportation Co. (SP) ✓
shall correct the deficiencies set forth in Exhibits 3,
4, and 5 for the trackage listed in Exhibit 11 no
later than December 31, 1981.


In all other respects D.93621 remains in full force and effect.
