ORDER EXTENDING TIME

In Decision (D.) 91847, as modified by D.92862 and D.92863, we directed that, within 180 days after the effective date of D.91847, Southern Pacific Transportation Company (SP) and the California Department of Transportation (CalTrans) shall negotiate and submit to this Commission for its approval an agreement relating to the equipment and facilities to be used in providing the rail commuter service between Los Angeles and Oxnard ordered in D.91847. The time for compliance with this requirement (Ordering Paragraph 5 of D.91847) was extended to January 31, 1982 by D.93661.

By letter dated January 13, 1982 CalTrans seeks, under Rule 43 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, a further 90-day extension of time to comply with Ordering Paragraph 5 of D.91847.

CalTrans states that it delivered to SP on January 4, 1982 a draft copy of a proposed agreement relating to equipment, facilities, and method for subsidizing deficits, and that a 90-day time for review and further discussion is required.

CalTrans' letter further states that SP concurs in the request for an extension of time. The letter was served on all parties to the proceeding. No response has been received by the Commission.

In the circumstances, we find that the requested extension of time to comply with Ordering Paragraph 5 of D.91847 is reasonable. We conclude that the request should be granted. As the current compliance date has passed, this order should be made effective immediately.

IT IS ORDERED that the time for compliance with Ordering Paragraph 5 of D.91847 is extended to May 4, 1982. This order is effective today.
