ORDER EXTENDING TIME

San Pedro Marine, Inc. (San Pedro), a vessel common carrier, by petition dated December 24, 1981 has requested an extension of time in which to comply with provisions of Decision (D.) 92076. Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 2 of that decision authorized San Pedro to establish the increased rates as sought within a specified time period.

San Pedro claims that it did not receive a copy of D.92076, nor had its attorney Christ Troupis of the firm of Minor, Popeney & Lebetesammer. San Pedro, therefore, claims that it was unaware of the time limitation requirements of Ordering Paragraphs 1 and 2 of D.92076.

Findings of Fact

1. D.92076 authorized San Pedro increases in its rates and charges for transportation as a vessel common carrier.
2. San Pedro has not taken the increases as authorized, alleging no receipt of D.92076.

Conclusion of Law

The petition for extension of time should be granted.


