O P I N I O N

By this application Southern California Edison Company (Edison) requested authority to reduce its Energy Cost Adjustment Billing Factors (ECABF) and to incorporate into its tariff a "Fuel Oil Inventory Adjustment provision." The requested decrease in the ECABF was authorized by D.92306. ✓

The proposed "Fuel Oil Inventory Adjustment provision" responds to conditions that were addressed in D.92496 in OII 56. Edison's proposal was before the Commission in that matter and was discussed in the course of reaching the adopted treatment of fuel oil inventory. Therefore, its request in this proceeding is moot. There being nothing further to come before the Commission, this proceeding should be discontinued.

Findings of Fact

1. The rate decrease requested by Edison in this matter was granted in D.92306.
2. The "Fuel Oil Inventory Adjustment provision" requested by Edison was addressed in D.92496.

Conclusion of Law

The fuel oil inventory adjustment issue is moot.

O R D E R


IT IS ORDERED that this matter is dismissed without prejudice.
