ORDER OF DISMISSAL AND TRANSFER OF FILE

By its Application (A.) 60936 filed September 24, 1981 Southern California Edison Company (SCE) seeks a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct and operate a 220 kV transmission line between Devers and Mirage Substations in Riverside County.

By letter dated October 23, 1981, our Executive Director informed SCE that A.60936 was incomplete because it failed to meet the requirements of General Order (GO) 131-B and Rule 17.1, relating to environmental data. Further, he listed the deficiencies and informed

SCE that Section VII B of GO 131-B requires it to correct any deficiencies within 60 days or explain in writing to the Commission staff why it is unable to do so.

In response to the letter SCE filed additional information as a supplement to A.60936 on December 22, 1981. This filing was docketed as A.61149.

The September 24, 1981 letter of our Executive Director did not accept the filing of A.60936. The statutory time limit to approve or disapprove the project commences when the application is accepted as complete. There should be only one application for this project. Therefore, A.60936 should be dismissed. However, the file in A.60936 should be transferred by reference to A.61149 filed December 22, 1981, because a good portion of it is applicable to A.61149.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A.60936 is dismissed.

2. The file and pleadings in A.60936 are transferred by reference to A.61149.
