Application of the Keswick Community Services District acting through its Board of Directors for an order authorizing the conversion of a private crossing at grade crossing the Spur Line of the Southern Pacific Railroad, being at Engineer's Station 121+30, or MP 263.19, into a public crossing.

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The Keswick Community Services District has requested authority to convert a private grade crossing in Shasta County across the tracks of Southern Pacific Transportation Company's Matheson Branch Line to a public crossing.

Applicant is not the proper party to apply for the public crossing. Applicant's organization was formed under Community. Services District Law, and is basically a water supply agency, but has no authority to construct public roads. Rule 38 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure states, "Applications to construct a public road, highway, or street across a railroad must be made by the municipal, county, state or other governmental authority which proposes the construction..."

Applicant was notified that it is not the proper party to apply for the crossing by letter of November 27, 1981. No response has been received.

IT IS ORDERED that Application 61001 is dismissed.
