ORDER DENYING REHEARING OF DECISION 93784

A petition for rehearing of Decision (D.) 93784 has been filed by Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (Pacific). We have carefully reviewed each and every allegation and are of the opinion that good cause for granting rehearing has not been shown.

By D.93784 we gave Pacific the option of providing telephone service to complainants on Norman Carlin's (Carlin) houseboat residence, located at "D" dock, Gate 5, Waldo Point Harbor. Pacific does have safe and lawful access to serve Carlin's boat via "D" dock. Therefore, Pacific is directed to provide telephone service to complainants on Carlin's boat. Should Pacific be denied access to Carlin's boat for the purpose of furnishing service on behalf of complainants, Pacific shall take reasonable steps to obtain such access.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED:

1. Rehearing of D.93784 is denied.

2. If necessary, Pacific shall take reasonable steps to obtain access to furnish service to complainants.
