ORDER STAYING ORDERING PARAGRAPH NO. 17 OF DECISION (D.) 93887

Applications for rehearing and petitions for modification of D.93887 have been filed by a number of parties in this proceeding, including Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E). Among the allegations of error in PG&E's application for rehearing is that Ordering Paragraph No. 17 is unlawful. By a petition for modification filed on February 5, 1982, PG&E points out that

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph No. 17 of D.93887 is stayed until further order of this Commission.


