The Commission has been informed that there is an inadvertent omission in Appendix A of Decision (D.) 93072. Original Page 3 of that appendix should have included authority to transport "Sand, between Oceanside, on the one hand, and all points and places in the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange and San Diego, on the other hand." This authority was originally granted in Appendix A of D.63042 dated August 29, 1961 in Application (A.) 43047 and was acquired by Royal Transportation Inc., the transferor in this proceeding, by D.69646 dated September 8, 1965 in A.47775.



\*Expedite Truck Lines by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted in the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to conduct operations as a highway common carrier as defined in Public Utilities Code Section 213 for the following transportation:

\*I. General Commodities:

\*A. Between all points in Los Angeles Basin Territory as described in Note A.

Except that under the authority granted, carrier shall not transport any shipments of:

1. Used household goods, personal effects and office, store, and institution furniture, fixtures and equipment not packed in salesman's hand sample cases, suitcases, overnight or boston bags, briefcases, hat boxes, valises, traveling bags, trunks, lift vans, barrels, boxes, cartons, crates, cases, baskets, pails, kits, tubs, drums, bags (jute, cotton, burlap, or gunny) or bundles (completely wrapped in jute, cotton, burlap, gunny, fibreboard, or straw matting).
2. Automobiles, trucks, and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses, and taxis, freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses, and bus chassis.
3. Livestock, viz.: barrows, boars, bulls, butcher hogs, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, feeder pigs, gilts,

goats, heifers, hogs, kids, lambs, oxen,  
pigs, rams (bucks), sheep, sheep camp  
outfits, sows, steers, stags, swine,  
or wethers.

4. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers, or a combination of such highway vehicles.
  5. Commodities when transported in bulk in dump-type trucks or trailers or in hopper-type trucks or trailers.
  6. Commodities when transported in motor vehicles equipped for mechanical mixing in transit.
  7. Logs.
  8. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerator equipment.
- \*B. Between all points in Los Angeles Territory as described in Note B, on the one hand, and San Diego Territory as described in Note C, on the other hand (excluding service to intermediate points).

Except that under the authority granted, carrier shall not transport any shipments of:

1. Used household goods, personal effects and office, store, and institution furniture, fixtures and equipment not packed in salesman's hand sample cases, suitcases, overnight or boston bags, briefcases, hat boxes, valises, traveling bags, trunks, lift vans, barrels, boxes, cartons, crates, cases,

baskets, pails, kits, tubs, drums, bags (jute, cotton, burlap, or gunny) or bundles (completely wrapped in jute, cotton, burlap, gunny, fibreboard, or straw matting).

2. Automobiles, trucks, and buses, viz.: new and used, finished or unfinished passenger automobiles (including jeeps), ambulances, hearses, and taxis, freight automobiles, automobile chassis, trucks, truck chassis, truck trailers, trucks and trailers combined, buses, and bus chassis.
3. Livestock, viz.: barrows, boars, bulls, butcher hogs, calves, cattle, cows, dairy cattle, ewes, feeder pigs, gilts, goats, heifers, hogs, kids, lambs, oxen, pigs, rams (bucks), sheep, sheep camp outfits, sows, steers, stags, swine, or wethers.
4. Liquids, compressed gases, commodities in semiplastic form and commodities in suspension in liquids in bulk, in tank trucks, tank trailers, tank semitrailers, or a combination of such highway vehicles.

7. Commodities requiring the use of special refrigeration or temperature control in specially designed and constructed refrigerator equipment.

\*II. Sand, between Oceanside, on the one hand, and all points and places in the Counties of Los Angeles, Orange, and San Diego, (except Oceanside), on the other hand.
