SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

Southern California Edison Company (Edison), requests a refund of fees paid under Public Utilities (PU) Code Sections 1904(b) and 1904.1.

By Decision (D.) 92026, dated July 15, 1980, in Application (A.) 59712, the Commission authorized Edison to issue up to \$125,000,000 of preferred stock. Edison paid \$68,500, the fee set by PU Code Section 1904.1.

By D.92189, dated September 3, 1980, in A.59836, the Commission authorized Edison to issue up to \$200,000,000 of First and Refunding Mortgage Bonds (Bonds). Edison paid \$65,500, the fee set by PU Code Section 1904(b), after taking credit for the retirement of \$6,000,000 principal amount of First Mortgage Bonds, Series 2-7/8%, due 1980, and the retirement of \$75,000,000 principal amount of Convertible Debentures, 3-1/8%, due 1980.

Edison informed the Commission by letter dated January 8, 1982 that it issued only \$75,000,000 of preferred stock, and issued only \$150,000,000 of Bonds. Edison requests a refund of \$50,000, applicable to \$50,000,000 of preferred stock and to \$75,000,000 of Bonds, which were authorized but not issued. Therefore, good cause appearing,


IT IS ORDERED that a refund of \$50,000, shall be made to Southern California Edison Company.
