ORDER TERMINATING PROCEEDING

This investigation was entered to find means of providing an adequate and safe water service to the approximately 146 customers of Meadowbrook Water Company, Inc. (MB). Decision (D.) 82-02-94 in Application 82-02-16 authorized the transfer of MB's assets to Crestline-Lake Arrowhead Water Agency (CLAWA), a public district. CLAWA intends to provide service to MB's customers and to provide funds to improve service. D.82-02-94 also rescinded the appointment of Meadowbrook Homeowners Association as temporary manager of MB pending sale of the system. In the circumstances, the investigation in Order Instituting Investigation (OII) 96 is moot and should be terminated.


IT IS ORDERED that the investigation instituted in OII 96 is terminated and that proceeding is closed.
