ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 1, 1979 by Decision (D.) 90048 the Commission concluded that the order to show cause in re contempt and the contempt order issued in D.89729 against Ronald J. Ratti and Donald L. Fassett were defective and therefore rescinded them, stating further that the Commission would consider whether the issuance of a new order to show cause in re contempt against Ronald J. Ratti and Donald L. Fassett would be warranted. These proceedings were kept open.


