ORDER DENYING REHEARING
OF DECISION (D.) 93889

Two applications for rehearing of D.93889 have been filed, one by General Motors Corporation (GM) and the other by Owens-Corning Fiberglas Corporation (Owens). As to the former, GM was not a party to this proceeding and does not purport to be a stockholder, a bondholder or be otherwise pecuniarily interested in PG&E. GM is therefore precluded from filing an application for rehearing (Section 1731, Public Utilities Code) and its filing must be dismissed.

We have carefully considered each and every allegation of error in Owen's application and are of the opinion that good cause for granting rehearing has not been shown. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

Rehearing of D.93889 is denied. GM's application for rehearing is dismissed.


