ORDER MODIFYING DECISION 82 01 09
AND DENYING REHEARING

Industrial Communications Systems, Inc. has filed an application for rehearing of Decision No. 82 01 09. The Commission has considered each and every allegation contained in said application and is of the opinion that good cause for rehearing of said Decision has not been shown. However, D. 82 01 09 should be modified to add findings of fact and conclusions of law. In addition, an ordering paragraph will be added containing a restriction on marketing, advertising or soliciting activities by Radiocall to the South Bay area. Therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that D. 82 01 09 is modified as follows:

1. Finding of Fact 4 is amended to read:

"Applicant presently has 24 two-way mobile customers. The mobile transient service available from other RTU's in the Greater Los Angeles Metropolitan Area requires Radiocall's subscribers to pay transient rates which are higher than Radiocall's normal tariff rates."

2. Finding of Fact 9 is added as follows:

"The current two-way mobile call service is unsatisfactory in the proposed expanded service area."

3. Finding of Fact 10 is added as follows:

"The proposed expanded operation will be technically and economically feasible, adequate and of good quality."

4. Conclusion of Law 2 is added as follows:

"R. L. Mohr, dba Radiocall Corporation, is technically and financially qualified to install and operate additional communications facilities to utilize Channel No. 21 more fully in the Greater Los Angeles area."

5. Conclusion of Law 3 is added as follows:

"Restricting Radiocall to marketing its two-way mobile call services as well as its tone-only paging and tone-and-voice paging services within its original certificated service area will avoid excessive competition and possible adverse economic effects therefrom in the expanded service area."

6. Ordering Paragraph ⁶ is added as follows: u


"Radiocall is prohibited from marketing, soliciting, or advertising its services outside of its original certificated service area, commonly known as the South Bay."

Rehearing of D. 82 01 00, as modified herein, is denied.
This order is effective today.
