ORDER DISCONTINUING PROCEEDING

This investigation was instituted January 13, 1976, to implement the provisions of Public Utilities (PU) Code Sections 2781 through 2788 (Chapter 6). These sections provide that the Commission shall permit any gas or electric utility to institute a home insulation assistance and financing program and direct the Commission to develop and adopt, by regulation or order, such requirements as it finds necessary or desirable to implement the chapter.

Since the investigation was instituted, the affected utilities have all requested Commission authorization to implement low-interest and/or zero interest energy conservation financing programs. With the approval and implementation of these programs, it is no longer necessary to continue this investigation. This proceeding should be discontinued.

IT IS ORDERED that Case 10032 is discontinued.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.


