BEFORE THE PUBLIC UTILITIES COMPLISSION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA

GERMAN A. MAGANA for authority to operate as a Fassenger Stage Corporation to provide home-towork service between individual homes of Regional Center clients and their places of training in the areas of City of L.A., East L.A., West L.A., Hollywood and Marbor areas. (Subject to 14-day protest period from initial filing date.)

## <u>O P I N I O K</u>

German A. Maganz, doing business as Desirec's Transportation (applicant), proposes to provide home-to-work service between individual homes of Regional Center clients and their places of training at various locations in Los Angeles County.

Applicant proposes to charge a round-trip fare of \$10.90 for each passenger.

Hone-to-work commuter buses play an important role in providing increased public transportation and helping to relieve the energy shortage. New services, such as proposed in this application, should be encouraged and one way to do so is by expediting their authorization. On the basis of the information furnished in the application, we find that public convenience and necessity require that the proposed service be authorized for a one-year term, subject to certain conditions as set forth in more detail in the following order.

## ORDER

#### IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to German A. Magana, an individual, authorizing him to operate as a passenger stage corporation as defined in Public Utilities Code Section 226, between the points and over the routes set forth in Appendix A.

- 2. Applicant shall:
  - a. File a written acceptance of this certificate within 30 days after this order is effective.
  - Establish the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables within 120 dzys after this order is effective.
  - c. State in his tariffs and timetables when service will start; allow at least 10 days' notice to the Commission; and make timetables and tariffs effective 10 or more days after this order is effective.
  - c. Comply with General Orders Series 79, 98, 101, and 104, and the California Highway Fatrol Safety rules.
  - e. Maintain accounting records in conformity with the Uniform System of Accounts.

3. The authority granted by this order shall remain in effect for a period of one year from the effective date of this order or until modified by further order of this Commission.

4. Applicant is placed on notice that if he accepts this expedited authorization that he waives his rights to invoke the protective provisions of Public Utilities Code Section 1032 as related to applications of other parties for similar authority for the period this authorization is in effect.

SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS.

German A. Magana by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized as a passenger stage corporation to transport passengers, between the individual homes of Regional Center clients and training centers located at various locations in Los Angeles County, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify the routes at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- a. When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction\_unless otherwise indicated.
- b. No passenger shall be transported except those having point of origin or destination at one of the locations identified in Section 2.
- c. This authority expires one year from the effective date of this decision.
