O P I N I O N

Applicant J.R. Bus Lines, Inc., a California corporation, requests a Class B certificate to operate as a charter-party carrier of passengers from a service area within a radius of 40 air miles from its home terminal at 215 West Pomona Boulevard, Monterey Park, California.

Applicant states that its officers and associates have 65 years of combined experience in the transportation industry. As of October 30, 1981 its total assets were \$89,504 and its total liabilities were \$56,608. It projects annual revenues of \$112,000 and annual expenses of \$88,685 in charter operations of its three 1965 MCI 41-passenger buses.

Notice of the filing of the application appeared on the Commission's Daily Calendar of December 15, 1981, and a copy of the application was served on, among others, Greyhound Lines, Inc. No protest has been received.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant has the ability, experience, equipment, and financial resources to perform the proposed service.
2. Public convenience and necessity require the service proposed by applicant.
3. Applicant should be authorized to pick up passengers within a radius of 40 air miles from its home terminal at 215 West Pomona Boulevard, Monterey Park, California.
4. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

Conclusions of Law

1. Public convenience and necessity have been demonstrated and a certificate should be granted.
2. Applicant should be authorized to pick up passengers within a radius of 40 air miles from his home terminal.
3. Since there is an immediate public need for the service, the order should be effective today.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity, to be renewed each year, is granted to applicant J.R. Bus Lines, Inc., authorizing it to operate as a Class B charter-party carrier of passengers, as defined in PU Code Section 5383, from a service area with a radius of 40 air miles from applicant's home terminal at 215 West Pomona Boulevard, Monterey Park, California.
2. The Passenger Operations Branch will issue the annual renewable certificate on Form PE-695 as authorized by Resolution PE-303, when it receives California Highway Patrol clearances and evidence of liability protection in compliance with General Order Series 115.


3. In providing service under the certificate, applicant shall comply with General Orders Series 98 and 115, and the California Highway Patrol safety rules.

This order is effective today.
