## <u>opinion</u>

Lark Rentals, Ltd., a limited partnership, seeks a cement contract carrier permit to transport cement in the Counties of Contra Costa, Solano, and Napa.

Applicant's business location is in Concord. It holds a highway contract carrier permit under File T-136,706.

Copies of the application were served on various carrier and shipper associations. Notice of the application appeared in the Commission's Daily Calendar of December 8, 1981. No protests have been received.

## Findings\_of Fact

- 1. Applicant:
  - a. Is fit and proper to receive a permit to operate as a cement contract carrier.
  - b. Has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.
  - c. Has demonstrated that the privilege sought:
    - (1) Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the public highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them, directly or indirectly.

- (2) Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
- (3) Will not impair the ability of presently permitted cement contract carriers to provide or to continue to provide adequate service as such at the lowest possible reasonable rates.
- 2. Carlos Murillo, the partner having the largest percentage interest, has resided continuously in California for 90 days preceding the filing of this application.
- 3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.
- 4. The following order complies with the guidelines of the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.
- 5. A public hearing is not necessary. Conclusion of Law

Applicant should be granted a cement contract carrier permit authorizing operations from any and all points of origin to all points in the Counties of Contra Costa, Solano, and Napa.

The following order should be effective on the date of signing to be consistent with other permit grants.

## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that the Executive Director shall issue a cement contract carrier permit to Lark Rentals, Ltd., Matthew Gonsalves. Carlos Murillo, Raymond Santucci, Gerald Santucci, William Gonsalves, John Gonsalves, Steven Gonsalves, and Al Jones, general partners; and John Rawleigh and James Dyess, limited partners. The permit will authorize operations from any and all points of origin to all points in the Counties of Contra Costa, Solano, and Napa.
