Applicant Kerry Dorothy Brown seeks authority to operate as a Class "B" charter-party carrier of passengers from her headquarters in Lake Arrowhead, California. Applicant proposes to provide the service with one 1966 Eagle 46-passenger bus owned by applicant.

Applicant's home terminal is located at 1294 Kodiak Drive, Lake Arrowhead, California 92352.

Notice of filing of the application appeared on the Commission's Daily Calendar dated December 8, 1981. In addition, copies of the application were mailed by applicant to all carriers who might be affected by the proposed service. No protests to the application were received.

Applicant's experience has been with a travel agency for two years where she was involved in setting up travel and hotel accommodations. She also worked for four years with charter bus operations setting travel, hotel, and bus service routings and rates. Applicant's balance sheet shows assets of \$52,501 with total liabilities of \$700. Applicant's bank is the Security Pacific National Bank located at 27235 Highway 189, Blue Jay, California 92317. She lists her insurance broker as Zodiac Insurance, 1302 West Whittier Boulevard, Montebello, California.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant has the ability, experience, equipment, and financial resources to perform the proposed service.

2. Public convenience and necessity require the service proposed by applicant.

3. A public hearing is not necessary.

4. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

Conclusion of Law

Public convenience and necessity having been demonstrated, a certificate should be granted to pick up passengers within a radius of 40 air miles from applicant's home terminal at Lake Arrowhead, California.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity, to be renewed each year, is granted to Kerry Dorothy Brown authorizing her to operate as a Class B charter-party carrier of passengers, as defined in PU Code Section 5383, from a service area with a radius of 40 air miles from applicant's home terminal at 1294 Kodiak Drive, Lake Arrowhead, California 92352.

2. The Passenger Operations Branch will issue the annual renewable certificate on Form PE-695, as authorized by Resolution PE-303, when it receives California Highway Patrol clearances and evidence of liability protection in compliance with General Order Series 115.
