The Commission staff has informed us that Finding 5 in Decision 82-01-90 should be clarified.


Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that Finding 5 is amended, consistent with the adopted tariff provisions, to state:

Four Corners' request to increase its late payment charge to 125% of the prime rate charged by the Citibank N.A. of N.Y. as of the due date, or the maximum rate allowed by law, whichever is less is not reasonable. The staff's recommendation to increase the late payment charge to the maximum rate allowed by law is reasonable.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
