ORDER MODIFYING DECISION 82-02-027
AND DENYING REHEARING

Orange Coast Sightseeing Company has filed a petition for rehearing of Decision (D.) 82-02-027. The Commission has considered each and every allegation contained in said application and is of the opinion that good cause for rehearing of D.82-02-027 has not been shown. However, two errors should be corrected. The decision states that the Knott's Berry Farm tour was inadvertently omitted from the original application filed by JETOUR. This is inaccurate because the tour was included in the original application in Exhibit C. The tour was inadvertently omitted from later filed statistical exhibits relied on by the Commission in granting D.93079. The decision should be modified accordingly to correct this misstatement. Also, there is a typographical error in the fourth paragraph. Therefore, D.93725 should read D.93726.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that D.82-02-027 is modified as follows:

1. Page 1, paragraph 2 is amended to read:

"By an amendment filed August 5, 1981, JETOUR requests the inclusion of a Knott's Berry Farm and Movieland Wax Museum tour, which was inadvertently omitted from statistical exhibits relied on by the Commission in granting D.93079."

2. The first sentence of page 1, paragraph 4 is amended to read:

"On November 13, 1981 we issued D.93726 in A.59818 et al. reanalyzing whether sightseeing-tour service is passenger stage corporation service."


Rehearing of D.82-02-027, as modified herein, is denied.
