ORDER EXTENDING TIME

Decision (D.) 82-01-80 dated January 19, 1982 directed Peter K. Greene (Greene), doing business as P. K. Greene Trucking, to cease and desist from violating applicable rules governing subhaul agreements and payments to dump truck subhaulers and to pay a punitive fine of \$500 by April 9, 1982.

By letter dated April 8, 1982, Greene requested a three months' extension of time to pay the fine. He stated that business has been very slow during the past three months because of bad weather and the economy and that this has had a severe adverse effect on the financial condition of his business.

We find that the request is reasonable and conclude that an extension to July 30, 1982 should be granted. Because there is an immediate need for the relief, this order should be made effective on the date signed.

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The due date of the \$500 fine imposed on Greene by D.82-01-80 is extended to July 30, 1982.
2. In all other respects D.82-01-80 shall remain in full force and effect.

This order is effective today.


