## ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Applicant applied for authority to operate as a Passenger Stage Corporation between Cambria and San Simeon.

On January 8, 1982, the Commission staff sent applicant a letter requesting a balance sheet.

On March 3, 1982, the Commission staff sent a letter reminding applicant of the previous request and that, if the staff did not hear from applicant by April 1, 1982, the staff would be forced to recommend the application be dismissed.

Applicant has not responded to the 2 letters.

It appears and the Commission finds that these actions constitute good cause for dismissal of the application and that such dismissal would not be adverse to the public interest. The Commission, therefore, concludes the application should be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Application 60724 by Cambria Pines Lodge is dismissed without prejudice.
