ORDER CLOSING CONSOLIDATED PROCEEDING

In the general rate proceeding phase (Application (A.) 58440) of the consolidated matters, we have issued two interim decisions. Through the second of the interim decisions (D.) (D.91915 dated June 17, 1980), the rate case issues, other than fair rate of return, were resolved and for that remaining issue a provisional rate of return was established pending further hearing. By letter dated April 13, 1982 counsel for Laguna Hills Water Company (LHWC) indicated that LHWC does not intend to proceed further with A.58440 because it will very shortly file a new general rate increase application.

In A.59032 LHWC sought authority to incur \$1.4 million in long-term debt and to establish a surcharge in its rates. D.93587 dated October 6, 1981 in A.58861, A.59023, A.59051, A.59748, and A.60490 of the A.58440 and related matters proceeding and D.93589 also dated October 6, 1981 in A.60490 and A.60491 have resulted in making the relief requested in A.59032 no longer necessary. LHWC filed its motion to dismiss A.59032 on February 26, 1982.

LHWC has informed us, by letter dated April 26, 1982, that it has made the refunds required plus interest in satisfaction of the above-entitled formal complaints.

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Good cause thus appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Case (C.) 10578, C.10595, C.10604, C.10605, C.10606, C.10607, C.10610, C.10757, and C.10764 and Application (A.) 59032 are dismissed.

2. The proceeding in A.58440 and related matters is terminated.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
