ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Application (A.) 82-04-04, Sierra Pacific Power Company (Sierra) requests authority to reduce its present Energy Cost Adjustment Clause (ECAC) rate of 41.11 mills/kWh to 39.09 mills/kWh for a revision date of June 1.

In our decision issued recently on Sierra's prior ECAC application, A.61119, we adopted an ECAC rate of 37.53 mills/kWh. Since that decision was issued well past the revision date of February 1, the adopted rate of 37.53 mills/kWh takes effect for less than a month under the established ECAC revision schedule for Sierra of February 1, June 1, and October 1. We see little point in adopting a new ECAC rate for such a short interval. Instead, we will dismiss A.82-04-04 and leave the adopted ECAC rate of 37.53 mills/kWh in effect until October 1. The net result of our action is postponement of the June 1 revision to October 1.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that:


1. A.82-04-04 is dismissed.
2. Sierra Pacific Power Company's next ECAC filing shall be tendered 60 days before the revision date of October 1.

This order becomes effective 30 days from today.
