O P I N I O N

Petitioners Arc Trucking Co., Inc., and M & M Trucking  
allege that the rates proposed by respondent Imperial Freight Lines,  
Inc., in Rate Reduction 743 (RR 743), now under suspension, are  
unreasonable and noncompensatory and request that RR 743 not be  
allowed to become effective. In its answer respondent denies that  
the proposed rates are unreasonable and noncompensatory. A hearing  
was held on the matter April 28, 1982 in San Francisco before  
Administrative Law Judge Pilling.

Shortly after the hearing commenced, the representative  
and witness for respondent (an employee of respondent) testified  
he had just been in telephonic communication with the president of  
respondent who instructed him to request that RR 743 be withdrawn.  
That request was made. No objection to the request was received.  
The hearing was then closed.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. Rate Reduction 743 is withdrawn.
2. (I&S) Case 82-03-01 is dismissed.
