ORDER EXTENDING TIME

In Decision (D.) 93887, Appendix F, page 2, we revised electric tariff Schedule A-21 to make that voluntary time-differentiated rate available to customers with demands below 500 kilowatts (kW) on July 1, 1982. Rehearing of D.93887 was granted on February 17, 1982, although the effective date of the decision was not stayed. The A-21 rate schedule was a major issue in the further hearings which were submitted upon the receipt of briefs on June 25, 1982.

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E), by Petition for Modification filed June 9, 1982, requests that the expansion of the A-21 rate schedule be postponed until after the final decision is issued in Application (A.) 60153.

Because there is a wide range of possible programs and rate designs that could emerge from the reopened proceedings in A.60153, PG&E's request is reasonable and will be granted.

IT IS ORDERED that D.93887, Appendix F, Page 2, regarding Schedule A-2¹ is modified to read:

"Applicability:

"Upon further order, this schedule will be optional for polyphase general service customers with a peak demand below 500 kW."


