ORDER STAYING DECISION (D.) 82-04-114

An application for rehearing of D.82-04-114 has been filed by Southern California Gas Company (SoCal Gas). On June 1, 1982, a document entitled "Petition for Rehearing and Modification of Decision No. 82-04-114 on Behalf of the California Gas Producers Association" was received in the Executive Director's office and accepted for filing as an application for rehearing by the Docket Office. The last day for filing applications for rehearing was May 28, 1982, the date upon which D.82-04-114 became effective (Section 1731 Public Utilities Code). Therefore, this filing was accepted in error. However, we have the discretion to

consider the document as a petition for modification in accordance with its title which is stated in the alternative and we have done so.

We are reviewing the allegations of error and requests for modification in these filings and will respond to them on their merits in a subsequent order. However we are of the opinion that D.82-04-114 should be stayed pending the completion of that review. Therefore, good cause appearing,

IT IS ORDERED that, D.82-04-114 is stayed until further order of this Commission.


