ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The Sun Miner Corporation (Sun Miner) submitted a letter, dated August 17, 1981, seeking certain exemptions from the Commission's Decision 92251, as modified, concerning the use of a passive solar water heater, SM 1000, in its solar system. Upon review of this letter, the Commission considered that the subject matter should be submitted as a formal matter, and it was docketed on October 1, 1981 as Application 60952.

On October 21, 1981, the Energy Conservation Branch (ECB) wrote a letter to applicant requesting test data regarding its SM 1000 passive water heater. The Commission has received no response regarding this correspondence and applicant's telephone has been disconnected.


Furthermore, on June 22, 1982, ECB again wrote applicant stating that if Sun Miner did not respond within 30 days, the Commission would take steps to dismiss the application. On June 30, 1982, this letter was returned to the Commission by the Postal Service with the note "Moved, left no address" indicated on the envelope. In the circumstances, this matter should be dismissed.

IT IS ORDERED that Application 60952 is dismissed.
