ORDER MODIFYING DECISION 82-05-061 AND DENYING REHEARING

An application for rehearing of Decision (D.) 82-05-061 has been filed by Lorrie's Travel & Tours, Inc. An application for rehearing and reconsideration of D.82-05-061 was also filed by SFO Airporter, Inc. (SFO). However, because it was filed late, the Docket Office reclassified this document as a petition for modification.

We have carefully considered each and every allegation of error in the application for rehearing and in the petition for modification and are of the opinion that good cause for rehearing has not been shown.

However, D.82-05-061 should be modified to limit Applicant to providing on-call, low-cost limousine service in 8-passenger limousines as specified in the certificate attached to D.82-05-061. Therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that Conclusion of Law 2 in D.82-05-061 is modified as follows:

The phrase "with a 14-passenger van as backup" is deleted and the following sentence is added:

A.58877 L/KV:mbh

"Applicant is limited to providing service in luxury sedan limousines with a seating capacity of one driver and eight passengers."
