ORDER OF DISMISSAL

At hearing on June 28, 1982, the parties agreed that the complaint could be settled as follows:

- 1. Complainants have \$111.47 on deposit with the Commission. Of this sum, \$36.64 relates to this proceeding and \$74.83 relates to a more recently filed complaint. The parties agreed that \$36.64 may be sent to Continental Telephone Company of California (Continental) to be applied to complainants' account.
- 2. The amount in dispute here is \$50. The parties agreed that Continental would apply a \$25 credit to complainants' account as a compromise of the dispute.

This complaint having been settled by agreement of the parties at hearing, therefore,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. Continental Telephone Company of California (Continental) shall apply a \$25 credit to complainants' account.
- 2. Deposits by complainants of \$36.64 shall be disbursed to Continental.
 - 3. The complaint in Case 11053 is dismissed.
