O P I N I O N

This is a complaint by Edward F. Biggs against Pacific Gas and Electric Company. It involves a dispute over billing for electric service.

A duly noticed public hearing was held in this proceeding before Administrative Law Judge Donald B. Jarvis in San Francisco on July 8, 1982.

At the hearing the parties advised the Administrative Law Judge that the matter had been settled and requested it be dismissed in accordance with a stipulation on the disposition of moneys deposited with the Commission by the Complainant. The stipulation was received and the matter submitted.

The Commission finds and concludes that the moneys should be disbursed in accordance with the stipulation and the matter dismissed with prejudice. Since the ensuing order disburses moneys deposited with the Commission, it should be effective on the date of issuance.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. Complainant's deposits of \$331.24 and any other deposits made by Complainant in connection with this complaint shall be disbursed as follows:

- a. The sum of \$145.00 shall be disbursed to Complainant Edward F. Biggs.
- b. The sum of \$186.24 and any other moneys which may have been deposited by complainant shall be disbursed to Defendant Pacific Gas and Electric Company.

2. The complaint is dismissed with prejudice.


