was filed supplying information required by the Rules of Practice

Case 10951 was a complaint against applicant which
sought, among other things, an order revoking its operating
authority for abandonment or disuse. In Decision 82-06-094
entered on June 15, 1982, the Commission revoked applicant's
operating authority. The order became final on July 15, 1982.

In the circumstances, the Commission finds and concludes that this application should be dismissed.


IT IS ORDERED that Application 61047 is dismissed.
