In the Matter of the Investigation for the purpose of considering and determining minimum rates for transportation of rock, sand, gravel and related items in bulk, in dump truck equipment in Southern California as provided in Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A and Southern California Production Area and Delivery Zone Directory 1, and the revisions or reissues thereof.

O P I N I O N

L. S. Hawley Corporation and Quality Rock Company, Inc. (petitioners) request modification of Minimum Rate Tariff 17-A (MRT 17-A) by adding new production areas in Ventura County with rates for the transportation of rock, sand, and gravel from the new areas to delivery zones in Ventura, Los Angeles, and Santa Barbara Counties.

A copy of each petition was served on 5 trucking associations having members who perform dump truck operations in the involved areas and on several business associations whose members either produce or use rock products. No protests to the petitions were received. The proceedings are consolidated in order to avoid duplication of tariff distribution.

MRT 17-A names minimum rates for the transportation by dump truck carriers of certain commodities including rock, sand, and gravel. The tariff contains zone rates which apply from defined production areas to designated delivery zones via a network of routes over most legally traversable highways in the Southern California areas where the rates apply.

Petitioner Hawley's new production facility is located 2.5 miles south of the intersection of Highway 101 and Pleasant Valley Road, near the community of Camarillo. The area covers approximately 204 acres.

Petitioner Quality Rock Company, Inc.'s new facility is located about 5 miles north of Moorpark.

Test traverses were conducted by petitioners from the new production facilities to nearest existing nodes within the existing system of zones. They are listed in the petitions, have been confirmed by the staff, and appear to be satisfactory.

Staff recommends, in connection with the request of petitioner Hawley, adding a new node at the south entrance to nearby Delivery Zone 56100. This will necessitate adding three new network links connecting with Delivery Zone 56100. The new links will not affect the rest of the network.

Adding these new production areas will result in reducing transportation costs to petitioners. Petitioners allege that establishing zone rates from the new production facilities will not cause any rate discrimination because producers of the same commodities in the same marketing area already have the benefit of zone rates to Ventura, Los Angeles, and Santa Barbara Counties delivery zones.

Findings of Fact

1. MRT 17-A names minimum rates for the transportation by dump truck carriers of certain commodities including rock, sand, and gravel via a network of routes over most legally traversable highways in Southern California.

2. Petitioners have recently established new production facilities, as described in the petitions, where rock, sand, and gravel are produced.

3. Present MRT 17-A rates do not apply to transportation performed from these newly established facilities.

4. The staff has verified information furnished by petitioners concerning traverse times from the new facilities to existing zone nodes. It recommends that the petitions be granted.

5. The rates adopted in the following order will result in just, reasonable, and nondiscriminatory minimum rates for the transportation involved.

6. A public hearing is not necessary.

7. The following order has no reasonably foreseeable impact on the energy efficiency of dump truck carriers.

Conclusions of Law

1. The petitions should be granted to the extent provided in the following order.

2. The effective date of this order should be today because there is an immediate need for this rate relief.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. MRT 17-A (Appendix C of Decision (D.) 80578, as amended) is further amended by incorporating Ninth Revised Page 9-Q and Original Pages 9-R, 9-R-1, 9-S, and 9-S-1, attached, to become effective 5 days after today.

2. Southern California Production Area and Delivery Zone Directory 1, (Appendix A of D.65469, as amended) is further amended by incorporating Fourth Revised Pages 281 and 282, attached, to become effective 5 days after today.

3. Common carriers subject to the Public Utilities Act, to the extent that they are also subject to D.80578 and D.65469, as amended, are authorized to establish in their tariffs the rates and routes necessary to conform with the further revisions ordered by this decision.

4. Tariff publications required to be made by common carriers as a result of this order shall be filed on not less than 5 days notice to the Commission and to the public if filed not later than 60 days after the effective date of the minimum rate tariff pages incorporated in this order.

5. Common carriers, in establishing and maintaining the rates authorized by this order, are authorized to depart from the provisions of Public Utilities Code § 461.5 to the extent necessary to adjust long- and short-haul departures now maintained under outstanding authorizations; such outstanding authorizations are modified only to the extent necessary to comply with this order; and schedules containing the rates published under this authority shall make reference to the prior orders authorizing long- and short-haul departures and to this order.

6. In all other respects D.80578 and D.65469, as amended, shall remain in full force and effect.

7. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of this decision on every common carrier, or such carriers' authorized tariff publishing agents, performing transportation services subject to MRT 17-A.


8. The Executive Director shall serve a copy of the tariff amendments on each subscriber to MRT 17-A.
