ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Glen Holden Esrig is requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity which appears identical to the authority currently held by him and Stephen B. Prine under PSC-1085. Esrig and Prine have apparently not yet agreed on a transfer of authority from a partnership to an individual. The authority is for transporting river rafters in the Sacramento area.

The California Legislature has recently amended the Public Utilities Code, Section 226(e), to exempt transportation of river rafters from PUC jurisdiction.

Since the requested authority is now beyond our jurisdiction, we will dismiss the instant application.


