ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Decision (D.) 82-04-007 dated April 6, 1982 in Case 10984, San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) was ordered to pay reparation to Carlton Hills School, Santee School District, (School) in a dispute involving the emergency replacement of a primary underground service for School. An application for rehearing of D.82-04-007 was filed by School. In D.82-06-101 the Commission granted rehearing limited to the receipt of evidence by the parties establishing labor cost attributable to applicant under SDG&E's tariff provision, Rule 16.B.b.

The parties negotiated on the amount to be paid School by SDG&E. By letter dated November 2, 1982 School transmitted a request for dismissal of the rehearing of D.82-04-007 based upon an agreement that SDG&E would pay School \$6,800 for the complete settlement of all of its claims in the complaint.
