ORDER OF DISMISSAL

Complainant Ray Garvin seeks an order requiring defendant County Estates Water Company to supply adequate water pressure for normal household usage.

Subsequent to the filing of the complaint, defendant installed a new water main to serve complainant's premises. Defendant informed the Commission staff that as a result of the new main an adequate supply of water is being provided at a pressure suitable for normal household usage.


By letter dated September 8, 1982, complainant was informed that unless we were notified to the contrary by October 11, 1982 we would assume that an adequate supply of water is being provided at a pressure suitable for normal household usage and that complainant did not wish to pursue the matter further. Such notification was not forthcoming.
