ORDER OF DISMISSAL

The International Solar Marketing, Inc. (International) submitted a letter, dated October 14, 1981, seeking certain exemptions from the Commission's Decision 92251, as modified, concerning the use of a passive solar water heater, Sunwest GZ 180, in its solar system. Upon review of this letter, the Commission considered that the subject matter should be submitted as a formal matter, and it was docketed on November 9, 1981 as Application 61048.

On August 12, 1982, the Energy Conservation Branch (ECB) wrote a letter to applicant requesting test data regarding its Sunwest GZ 180 Passive Solar Water Heater. In a Commission letter, dated November 4, 1982, confirming a telephone conversation initiated by ECB staff with applicant the previous day, staff was told that International did not intend to pursue the application due to a change in marketing plans.

Since the Applicant no longer wishes to seek exemptions from the checklist, this matter should be dismissed.


IT IS ORDERED that Application 61048 is dismissed.
