<u>O P I N I O N</u>

By Decision 82-01-88 dated January 19, 1982 in Application 61070, J. Warren Boyd (applicant) was granted a temporary certificate of public convenience and necessity (PSC-1205) as a passenger stage corporation for the operation of home-to-work bus service between Novato and Oakland.

By this application, applicant seeks to obtain permanent authority between Novato, points in Marin County, and Oakland. Applicant intends to provide this service using his currently owned fleet of operating equipment and to charge \$3.25 for a round trip and \$65 for a monthly pass. No other carrier is operating the service proposed by applicant.

The application was listed on the Commission's Daily Calendar. The Commission's Transportation Division staff has reviewed the application and recommends that in the absence of protest or request for public hearing, it be granted by ex parte order. No protest has been received.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant has the ability, equipment, and financial resources to perform the proposed service.

2. The proposed fares are reasonable.

3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

Conclusions of Law

1. A public hearing is not necessary.

2. Public convenience and necessity have been demonstrated and the application should be granted.

3. Because there is a continuing need for these important passenger services, this order should be effective today.

Only the amount paid to the State for operative rights may be used in rate fixing. The State may grant any number of rights and may cancel or modify the monopoly feature of these rights at any time.

ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. A certificate of public convenience and necessity is granted to J. Warren Boyd, authorizing him to conduct operations as a passenger stage corporation, as defined in PU Code Section 226, between the points and over the routes set forth in Appendix PSC-1205, to transport persons and their baggage.

- 2. Applicant shall:
 - a. File a written acceptance of this certificate within 30 days after this order is effective.

- b. Establish the authorized service and file tariffs and timetables within 120 days after this order is effective.
- c. State in his tariffs and timetables when the service will start; allow at least 10 days' notice to the Commission; and make timetables and tariffs effective 10 or more days after this order is effective.
- d. Comply with General Orders Series 79, 98, 101, and 104, and the California Highway Patrol safety rules.
- e. Maintain accounting records in conformity with the Uniform System of Accounts.

SECTION 1. GENERAL AUTHORIZATIONS, RESTRICTIONS, LIMITATIONS, AND SPECIFICATIONS.

J. Warren Boyd, by the certificate of public convenience and necessity granted by the decision noted in the margin, is authorized to operate as a passenger stage corporation to transport home-to-work passengers and their baggage between points, in Novato. Marin County, on the one hand, and Oakland, on the other hand, subject, however, to the authority of this Commission to change or modify this authority at any time and subject to the following provisions:

- a. All transportation of passengers shall originate at and shall be destined to : the service points specified in Section 2.
 - b. When route descriptions are given in one direction, they apply to operation in either direction unless otherwise indicated.
