ORDER OF DISMISSAL

By Decision (D.) 88905 dated May 31, 1978 in this proceeding, Death Valley Trucking, Inc. was granted interim authority to charge less than the minimum rates in Minimum Rate Tariff 7-A in connection with the transportation of clay and talc for Cypress Industrial Minerals Company. The interim authority granted by D.88905 expired on May 31, 1979. 
