FINAL ORDER

Under a stipulation between Blue & Gold Fleet (Blue & Gold), a California corporation, and staff we suspended Blue & Gold's certificate authorizing common carrier service by vessel between the San Francisco Ferry Building and Berkeley. (Decision (D.) 93151, dated June 2, 1981.) The suspension was to last 18 months, during which period Blue & Gold was to attempt to negotiate an operating agreement with California Department of Transportation. D.93151 provided that if negotiations were unsuccessful, Blue & Gold's certificate would expire 18 months after the effective date of D.93151. The effective date of D.93151 was July 2, 1981, and the 18-month period ended January 2, 1983.

From Blue & Gold's quarterly reports we learn that the negotiations were unsuccessful. Accordingly, since Blue & Gold's certificate has expired by the passage of time under the terms of D.93151, we should make that decision final and close this proceeding.
