ORDER MODIFYING DECISION 87745

By this application San Diego Gas & Electric Company (SDG&E) requests modification of Ordering Paragraph 5 of Decision (D.) 87745 dated August 23, 1977. In support of its request SDG&E claims the following to be the facts in this proceeding, and we find them to be so:

- 1. D.87745 authorized SDGSE's initial Time-of-Use (TOU) rate to be applied to its largest customers (A-6TOU).
- 2. Ordering Paragraph 5 of D.87745 addresses the monitoring, evaluation, and reporting requirements for the TOU rate and reads as follows:
 - "5. SDG&E shall carry out the monitoring and evaluation procedures contained in Appendix B of the staff report in this proceeding. The required annual reports to the Commission shall be filed on or before March I following the prior calendar year."
- 3. SDG&E has submitted the required reports for 1977 through 1931 inclusive.
- 4. The time restraint of reporting by March of the following year results in reports of lower quality and containing more errors than SDG&E deems desirable; a later reporting date would result in a higher quality report of greater value to the Commission.

- 5. Experience shows that a minimum of two months is required to properly validate, edit, and analyze the annual data base which is not complete and available until early February.
- 6. If the reports were submitted on May 1 instead of March 1, the problems noted in the above findings would be alleviated.
- 7. Staff of the Commission's Energy Conservation Branch recommends the filing date of the reports be March 31 each year to coincide with SDG&E's load management effectiveness reports filed annually on March 31.
- 8. SDG&E concurs with the Energy Conservation Branch's recommendation.

By letter to the assigned administrative law judge dated November 29, 1982 the staff of the Commission's Utilities Division states it does not oppose SDG&E's request. No other communications concerning the request have been received. It appears no useful purpose would be served by a public hearing and the application should be granted ex parte.

Additional Findings of Fact

- 9. A public hearing is not necessary.
- 10. Because the current due date of the next report is March 1, 1983, this order should be effective on the date signed. Conclusion of Law

Ordering Paragraph 5 of D.87745 should be modified as provided in the following order.

IT IS ORDERED that Ordering Paragraph 5 of D.87745 is modified to read as follows:

5. SDG&E shall carry out the monitoring and evaluation procedures contained in Appendix B of the staff report in this proceeding. The required annual reports to the Commission shall be filed on or before March 31 following the prior calendar year.
