ORDER CORRECTING DECISION 83-04-002

It has been brought to the Commission's attention that several minor typographical and/or errors of omission are contained in Decision (D.) 83-04-002. Upon review, we confirm such errata as follows:

Page 3, Section A.6.d., line 3, "insulation" should be changed to read "installation".

Page 5, Section D.L., line 1, "main" should be changed to read "mains".

Page 5, Section D.1., line 2, "fire-flow" should be changed to read "fire flow".

Page 5, Section D.1., line 3, following the word "Order", the word "No." should be added.

Page 5, Section D.1., line 4, the word "and" should be deleted.

The necessary corrections listed above are noncontroversial and will not prejudicially affect any person, corporation, or other entity.

Under Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that Page 3, Section A.6.d., and Page 5, Section D.1., of D.83-04-002 are corrected to read as follows:

A.83-03-11 ALJ/EA

<u>Section A.6.d.</u> - Such statement shall be submitted within 60 days after the actual construction costs of the installation have been ascertained by the utility. In the event that the actual construction costs for the entire installation shall not have been determined within 120 days after completion of construction work, a preliminary determination of actual and adjusted construction costs shall be submitted, based upon the best available information at that time.

<u>Section D.1.</u> - The cost of distribution mains designed to meet the fire flow requirements set forth in Section VIII.1(a) of General Order No. 103 is to be advanced by the applicant. Utilities shall refund this advance as provided in Sections B.2. and C.2. of this rule.

This order is effective today.
