O P I N I O N

Ramon West requests a dump truck carrier permit to operate in the Counties of Siskiyou, Shasta, and Trinity. Notice of the filing of the application appeared in the Daily Transportation Calendar of March 15, 1983. No protests have been filed.

Applicant has \$700,000 of assets; \$25,000 of this represents the value of his dump truck and trailer. His principal liability of \$20,000 is the balance due on that equipment.

One supporting shipper needs to move 25,000 tons of material per year in Siskiyou, Shasta, and Trinity Counties, generating \$46,000 in gross revenues. Another will need to transport 10,000 tons annually in those counties.

Findings of Fact

1. Applicant:

- a. Is a fit and proper person to receive a permit to operate as a dump truck carrier.
- b. Has sufficient operating knowledge and financial ability to initiate and continue the proposed operation.

c. Has demonstrated that the privilege sought:

- (1) Will not endanger the safety of the public or interfere with the public use of the public highways or impair the condition or maintenance of them, directly or indirectly.
- (2) Will not unnecessarily burden the public highways.
- (3) Is necessary to serve the public and will not impair the ability of presently permitted dump truck carriers to provide adequate service at the lowest possible reasonable rates.

2. Applicant has resided in the State of California for at least the 90 days preceding the filing of this application.

3. It can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the activity in question may have a significant effect on the environment.

4. The following order complies with the Commission's Energy Efficiency Plan.

5. A public hearing is not necessary.

Conclusions of Law

1. Applicant should be granted a dump truck carrier permit authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Siskiyou, Shasta, and Trinity.

2. The following order should be effective today to be consistent with other permit grants.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the Executive Director shall issue a dump truck carrier permit to Ramon West authorizing operations within and between points in the Counties of Siskiyou, Shasta, and Trinity upon compliance with General Order Series 100.


