ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On July 1, 1983, the Winton Sanitary District (District) filed a petition under Public Utilities (PU) Code Section 1401, et seq., requesting that the Commission fix the just compensation which shall be paid by the District for the lands, property, and rights of the Winton Water Company, Inc. (Company). Such lands, property, and rights consist of water supply facilities, pumping plant facilities, water treatment facilities, water storage facilities, transmission and distribution facilities, land and land rights, general plant structures, and miscellaneous properties as those items are more fully defined and described in paragraph VIII of the petition. Such lands, property, and rights are intended to comprise all of the water utility properties of the Company lying within its service area. PU Code § 1408 requires us to hold a hearing on the petition not less than 30 days after the filing of the petition.

Therefore, IT IS ORDERED that, under PU Code § 1405:

1. Winton Water Company, Inc., and such other persons and corporations as may own, or claim rights to, the lands, property, and rights described above, shall appear before the Commission at 10:00 a.m., Wednesday, August 31, 1983, in the Commission Courtroom at 350 McAllister Street, San Francisco, to show cause, if any they have, why the Commission should not proceed to hear the petition and to fix the just compensation to be paid for such lands, property, and rights.

2. The hearing on August 31, 1983 shall be in the nature of a prehearing conference and shall be for the purpose of:

- a. Identifying and simplifying the issues;
- b. Arriving at agreements for the completion of discovery;
- c. Arranging for the exchange of proposed exhibits or prepared expert testimony;
- d. Identifying witnesses;
- e. Arriving at stipulations;
- f. Scheduling further hearing dates;
- g. Determining the extra costs to be incurred by the Commission to comply with the requirements of Chapter 8 of Part 1 of Division 1 of the PU Code and the schedule of these payments to be made by the Winton Sanitary District;
- h. Considering whether service of this order to show cause ought to be made upon any person or corporation by publication under PU Code § 1407; and
- i. Discussing such other matters as may expedite the orderly conduct and disposition of the proceeding.


