ORDER CORRECTING CLERICAL ERROR

The Commission has been informed that there are two clerical errors in Decision 83-08-040. Accordingly, under Resolution A-4661,

IT IS ORDERED that the errors are corrected as follows:

1. In Ordering Paragraph 4, page 4, the words "degraded above" are deleted from the language in quotation marks; and
2. Ordering Paragraph 5, page 4, is denoted by the numeral 5, which had been inadvertently omitted.

The corrected portion of page 4 now reads:

4. The following sentence is added to the first paragraph on page 33:

"It follows that reparations are due to those customers (1) whose type 3001 channels were adjusted to a transmission loss greater than 10 dB, or (2) who were billed for Type 3001 service when Type 1009 service would have been adequate."


