ORDER EXTENDING STAY

On June 20, 1983, Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company (Pacific) filed an application for rehearing of D.83-06-021, thereby staying the order for 60 days unless we act within that time to grant or deny rehearing (§ 1733(a) Public Utilities Code). We are considering the allegations of error in Pacific's application, as well as those in the applications for rehearing subsequently filed by General Telephone Company of California and the Air Transport Association of America, and the request for modification filed by Southern California Edison Company. We will respond to those filings on their merits in a subsequent order. It is appropriate to extend the stay of D.83-06-021 pending such action.


Therefore, good cause appearing,
