COMMISSION RULING ON MOTION OF THE COMMISSION STAFF

The Commission Staff (Staff) filed its motion January 25, 1983 for a Commission order to require the Bay Area Rapid Transit District (BART) to retain an expert consultant to evaluate the fire safety characteristics of BART's proposed new "C" cars. On March 15, BART replied to the motion opposing it. On May 9, Staff responded to BART's reply.

We believe matters such as this should be administratively handled by our executive director as we stated in Decision 92479 dated December 2, 1980 (p. 4) in this proceeding.

Staff's motion is denied.
