## ORDER REOPENING PROCEEDING AND REJECTING TARIFFS

Decision (D.) 82-12-094 of December 15, 1982, in this proceeding among other things, ordered that tariffs of respondent utilities filed in compliance with the decision were to become effective on June 15, 1983, unless further postponed.

D.83-06-013 dated June 1, 1963, as amended by D.83-06-099 dated June 29, 1983, granted Pacific Gas and Electric Company's motion to postpone to September 30, 1963, the effective date of the new tariffs because of potential hardships that could be caused by proposed legislation in Senate Bill 48 (SB 48). SB 48 would retain the currently effective tariffs while the Legislature studies the effects of revisions to the line extension rules. SB 48 has been enacted. Therefore, the tariffs, as revised by the following Commission resolutions adopted June 1, 1983 should be rejected:

> Resolution G-2535 - CP National (gas and electric) Resolution G-2536 - Pacific Gas and Electric Company (gas and electric) Resolution G-2537 - San Diego Gas & Electric Company (gas and electric) Resolution G-2538 - Southern California Gas Company (gas)

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Resolution G-2539 - Southwest Gas Corportation (gas) Resolution E-1971 - Southern California Edison Company (electric) Resolution E-1972 - Sierra Pacific Power Company (electric) Resolution E-1973 - Pacific Power & Light Company

Further hearings in this proceeding should be scheduled to consider the procedural and other requirements of SB  $\frac{2}{2}$ . IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The proceeding in Case 10260 is reopened for further nearing. A prehearing conference to determine further Commission action with respect to gas and electric line extension rules will be scheduled at a date to be set.

2. The tariffs filed in compliance with D.82-12-094 are rejected.
