O P I N I O N

Complainant, Cheryl Anderson, requests the Commission to order defendant, San Diego Gas & Electric Company, to restore electric service at complainant's residence, 1221 Maryland Drive, Vista, California 92083. Defendant filed its answer within the time prescribed by the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure. Defendant's attempt to serve its answer on complainant at the 1221 Maryland Drive address was unsuccessful. Service was later effected at another address in Vista. As shown in an affidavit filed by defendant's attorney, defendant has restored electric service at the 1221 Maryland Drive address but to a third party who is now, and has been since July 1, 1983, the tenant of the property according to the manager of the property.

Finding of Fact

A third party and not complainant is a resident of and receiving electric service at the residence at which complainant requests restoration of service.

Conclusion of Law

Complainant no longer has a cause of action and the complaint should be dismissed.

O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Case 83-05-06 is dismissed.

This order is effective today.


